Item: Public Hearing\Resolution: Vacation of Easement #2016-39 – Artspace Hastings

Lofts

Council Action Requested:

Hold a public hearing and consider adoption of the attached resolution vacating a Drainage and Utility Easement over a portion of Outlot C, RIVERFRONT ADDITION.

Approval of the action requires a simple majority of the City Council.

Background Information:

The vacation is requested in conjunction with the purchase and development of the property by Artspace Hastings Lofts. The City Council has previously granted approvals to construct a mixed use building containing 37 residential units and commercial space on the site.

Public notice of the proposed action has been published, and all property owners within 350 feet of the site have been mailed notice. No comments have been received at this time.

Analysis:

Approval of the vacation is recommended. The easement is no longer needed. Necessary easements have been incorporated into the RIVERFRONT 2ND ADDITION, a replat of the property.

WHEREAS, Artspace Hastings Lofts LLLP, applicant, has petitioned on behalf of the Hastings Economic Development and Redevelopment Authority, property owner, for approval to vacate a ten foot drainage and utility easement generally located along the southern property boundary of Outlot C, RIVERFRONT ADDITION, legally described as follows:

All of the 10 foot wide drainage and utility easement adjoining the south line of OUTLOT C, RIVERFRONT ADDITION, and lying west of a line parallel with and 38.5 feet west, as measured at a right angle to the east line of OUTLOT B, RIVERFRONT ADDITION.

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2016, a public hearing on the proposed vacation was held before the City Council of the City of Hastings, which was preceded by proper notice, as required by state law, city charter, and city ordinance; and

WHEREAS, The City of Hastings in all respects proceeded with the vacation hearing as proceeded by the Charter, ordinances, and applicable Minnesota statues.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HASTINGS AS FOLLOWS:
