1. Public Hearing – Annual Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System Permit Report Caven introduced the item requesting Council to hold a Public Hearing for Hastings Annual Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan. The Federal Clean Water Act requires small cities to submit a permit to discharge storm water into receiving water bodies. The storm water permit typically covers a five year period and is intended to reduce pollutants from not only our storm sewer discharge points, but also from overland runoff that drains directly to rivers, lakes, and ponds. The City annually conducts a public hearing to present a summary of the annual storm water pollution prevention activities as part of its Storm Water Permit requirements.
